Cllr Thompson agreed to reinstate them. It was noted that parishioners are removing logs for the wood. The logs serve important ecological need. Wood decomposition is one of a woodland's essential recycling processes and a natural part of every tree's lifecycle. Dead and decaying wood also provides a nutrient-rich habitat for fungi, a nursery for beetle larvae and a larder for insectivorous birds and other animals.
